Welcome, parents and students! The Nashville Area Music Teachers Association invites you to participate in **Pianorama 2021: "Christmas Time is Here."** Pianorama is an opportunity for area students to perform piano duets in an ensemble setting.

Seth Gregory, notable pianist, conductor, and educator will be conducting rehearsals for the **Pianorama 2021** concert. We are excited he can join us!

Reserve the weekend of November 19, 20, and 21. Rehearsals are Friday, November 19 and Saturday, November 20. The **Pianorama** concert is Sunday, November 21 at 2:00 p.m. Attendance is **required** for both Friday and Saturday rehearsals to perform Sunday.

Registration with your teacher is **August 16 through September 30**. The teacher will notify participants of their rehearsal time for both Friday and Saturday. Rehearsal schedules will be released early October. Allow approximately one hour each day on campus.

Participant Fee: \$25.00 per participant (student, parent, family member, or friend). Participant fees are non-refundable. Your teacher will assign you to a **color** group.

Sunday Concert Admission: \$5.00 per person for non-performers. There is no charge for pre-school age and under. Concert tickets (open seating) may be purchased during rehearsals on Friday and Saturday. *Proceeds benefit the Young Artist Achievement Awards.*

Pianorama 2021 rehearsals and concert will be at Lipscomb University, Collins Alumni Auditorium. Visit www.Lipscomb.edu for campus map and parking.

PIANORAMA CHECKLIST

1. Students must be supervised by an adult while attending both rehearsals and concert.
2. Arrive promptly. Locate your color group in the auditorium for your assigned seat.
3. Be in your assigned seat 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time each day.
4. Bring your music and a pencil to rehearsals. All measures should be numbered.
5. Silence cell phones in the auditorium during the rehearsals and concert.
6. Bottled water is allowed in the auditorium. No food or gum is allowed.
7. Casual clothes are allowed for rehearsals. Dressy-festive attire is requested on Sunday.
8. Be in your assigned seat in the auditorium by 1:30 p.m. for Sunday's concert.
