Reserve the weekend of November 21st, 22nd, and 23rd.

Rehearsals are Friday, November 21st and Saturday, November 22nd. The **Pianorama** concert is Sunday, November 23rd at 2:00 p.m. Attendance is <u>mandatory</u> in both Friday and Saturday rehearsals in order to perform on the concert on Sunday.

Registration with your teacher is **September 15 through October 15**. The teacher will notify participants of their rehearsal time for both Friday and Saturday rehearsals. Official rehearsal schedules will be released once registration closes. Allow approximately one hour each day on campus.

Registration Fee: \$40 per participant (student, parent, family member, or friend). Registration fees are non-refundable. Your teacher will assign you to a **color** group.

Sunday Concert Admission: \$5.00 per person for non-performers. There is no charge for preschool age and under. Concert tickets (open seating) may be purchased online and in-person during rehearsals and on Sunday. *Proceeds benefit the Young Artist Achievement Awards*.

Pianorama 2025 rehearsals and concert will be at Lipscomb University, Collins Alumni Auditorium. Visit **www.Lipscomb.edu** for campus map and parking.

PIANORAMA CHECKLIST

- 1. Students must be supervised by an adult while attending both rehearsals and concert.
- 2. Arrive promptly. Locate your color group in the auditorium for your assigned seat.
- 3. Be in your assigned seat 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time each day.
- 4. Bring your music and a pencil to rehearsals. All measures should be numbered.
- 5. Silence cell phones in the auditorium during the rehearsals and concert.
- 6. Bottled water is allowed in the auditorium. No food or gum is allowed.
- 7. Casual clothes are acceptable for rehearsals. Dressy concert black attire is required on Sunday. Due to stage setup, heels and short hemlines are prohibited.
- 8. Be in your assigned seat in the auditorium by 1:30 p.m. for Sunday's concert.
